**IN RE: HB1834** by Ashby (Relating to invoices and payments under certain state contracts for outside legal services.), **As Introduced** 

### No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill amends Government Code Chapter 402 relating to attorney general review of outside legal services contracts. Specifically, the bill adds a timeline for agencies to submit invoices to the attorney general for review and adds language requiring the attorney general to determine whether the legal services within the invoice are within the terms and scope of the legal services authorized by the contract.

Based on the information and analysis provided by the Office of the Attorney General, no significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.
