#### IN RE: HB1895 by Nevárez (Relating to the investigation of municipal fire fighters.), Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

#### No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to modify established disciplinary procedures for municipal fire fighters.

According to the Commission on Fire Protection, no fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

#### Local Government Impact

According to the Texas Municipal League, the bill provides for the implementation of rules for dealing with firefighter misconduct. There would be a fiscal impact from developing and implementing these rules. There could be an additional fiscal impact were cities to experience more challenges to employment decisions.

According to the Commission on Fire Protection, no fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
