### No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to repeal a provision that establishes certain provisions relating to the operation of jail commissaries in certain counties.

According to the Commission on Jail Standards, no fiscal impact to the State is anticipated.

### Local Government Impact

According to the Texas Sheriffs' Association, the bill applies to one county only and would have no fiscal impact on the affected Sheriff's Office.
