**IN RE: HB2091** by Ortega (Relating to the use of promotoras and community health workers in Medicaid managed care.), **As Introduced** 

#### No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require the Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) to allow Medicaid managed care organizations to categorize services provided by a promotora or community health worker as a quality improvement cost instead of an administrative expense. According to HHSC, this practice is currently allowable and therefore no significant fiscal impact is anticipated.
