**IN RE: HB2198** by Clardy (Relating to the use of a perpetual trust fund for a cemetery by certain municipalities.), **As Engrossed**

The bill would amend the Health and Safety Code to authorize certain municipalities to abolish a perpetual trust fund for a cemetery and use the fund, including both principal and interest, for permanent improvements to the cemetery.
