IN RE: HB2477 by Coleman (Relating to automatic employee participation in and administration of a deferred compensation plan provided by certain hospital districts.), As Passed 2nd House

#### No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Government Code to authorize certain hospital districts to offer a deferred compensation plan that would include provisions for the automatic enrollment of new employees unless the employee affirmatively elects not to participate.

#### **Local Government Impact**

While hospital districts electing to automatically enroll new employees in a deferred compensation plan could have additional marginal costs due to an expected increase in enrollment, no significant fiscal implication to these districts is anticipated.
