IN RE: HB2566 by Dominguez (Relating to the authority of certain counties to regulate litter and mosquito control.), **As Engrossed**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to authorize certain counties to regulate litter and certain property that creates a nuisance or habitat conducive to mosquito breeding. This authorization would apply to unincorporated areas of the county.
