IN RE: HB2633 by Morrison (Relating to the consumption, possession, or sale of an alcoholic beverage at a performing arts facility leased to a nonprofit organization by a school district.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Alcoholic Beverage Code and the Education Code as it relates to alcoholic beverages at certain performing arts facilities.
