IN RE: **HB2634** by Flynn (Relating to municipal boundaries used to determine a cemetery location.), **As Engrossed**

The bill would amend the Health and Safety Code to modify certain parameters used by municipalities to determine the permissible location of cemeteries to include the presence of annexed areas primarily used for flood control.
