IN RE: HB2701 by White (Relating to county jailer training and continuing education requirements regarding interacting with pregnant women confined in jail.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

Based on the analysis from the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement, it is assumed that the provisions of the bill could be absorbed using existing resources. The bill would take effect September 1, 2019.
