IN RE: HB2775 by Krause (Relating to the movement of pedestrians in front of, under, between, or through rail cars at a railroad grade crossing.), **As Engrossed**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Transportation Code to prohibit pedestrian movement through trains occupying railroad grade crossings in certain circumstances.
