**IN RE: HB2886** by Bucy (Relating to the requirement for payment bonds from certain public work contractors.), **As Introduced**

The bill would amend portions of the Government Code relating to payment bonds from certain public work contractors.

The Facilities Commission, Military Department, Historical Commission, and Parks and Wildlife Department have indicated there would be no significant fiscal impact.
