**IN RE: HB2914** by Bell, Cecil (Relating to the necessity of hearings regarding the dissolution or conversion of certain conservation and reclamation districts.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Water Code to authorize the Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to adopt a dissolution or conversion order for certain districts without conducting a hearing under certain circumstances. The bill repeals a section of the Water Code as a conforming change.

**Local Government Impact**

According to TCEQ, the bill has a potential for cost savings to a district by avoiding additional costs associated with TCEQ hearings.
