IN RE: **HB3011** by Turner, Chris (Relating to requiring the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board to provide to a school district certain information used in determining academic accountability ratings for the district.), **As Introduced**

The bill would require the Higher Education Coordinating Board to provide a school district certain information used in determining academic accountability ratings for a district. This analysis assumes that any costs for the Higher Education Coordinating Board and the Texas Education Agency to implement the provisions of the bill could be absorbed within current resources.
