IN RE: HB3092 by Paul (Relating to notice of an epizootic infectious disease occurring in an animal shelter.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Health and Safety Code to require certain notices of epizootic infectious disease occurring in an animal shelter.

According to the Department of State Health Services (DSHS), because the diseases of concern (e.g., parvovirus, canine distemper, and *feline rhinotracheitis*) are not transmissible to humans the bill would have no impact on the agency.

Local Government Impact

According to DSHS, no fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
