**IN RE:** **HB3174** by Kuempel (Relating to covers or barriers on the windows and doors of and other obstructions of the view of certain alcoholic beverage retailers.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would repeal the Alcoholic Beverage Code as it relates to blinds and barriers on the premises of certain alcoholic beverage retailers. The Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission anticipates that the provisions of the bill would not result in a significant fiscal impact. The bill would take effect September 1, 2019.
