**IN RE: HB3246** by Darby (Relating to the treatment and recycling for beneficial use of certain waste arising out of or incidental to the drilling for or production of oil or gas.), **As Engrossed**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Natural Resources Code related to the treatment and recycling of certain waste from oil and gas production. Based on analysis of the Railroad Commission, duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.
