IN RE: HB3246 by Darby (Relating to treating and recycling for beneficial use certain liquid or semiliquid waste arising out of or incidental to drilling for or producing oil or gas.), As Introduced

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Natural Resources Code related to treating and recycling certain liquid or semiliquid waste from oil and gas production. Based on analysis of the Railroad Commission, duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.
