**IN RE:** **HB3304** by Raymond (Relating to the sunset review of the Texas Health Services Authority and the repeal of certain provisions affecting the electronic exchange of health information.), **As Passed 2nd House**

<p><b>No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.</b></p>
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The bill would repeal expiration provisions relating to the electronic exchange of health information under the Texas Health Services Authority (THSA). The bill would also place THSA under sunset review with an expiration of September 1, 2027, unless continued under the Texas Sunset Act.

The Department of State Health Services and the Health and Human Services Commission indicate that the provisions of the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.
