IN RE: HB3440 by Capriglione (Relating to the electronic submission of forms, data, and documents to the Commission on Jail Standards; imposing a fee.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Government Code as it relates to the electronic submission of certain reports to the Texas Commission on Jail Standards (TCJS). According to TCJS, duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be absorbed within existing resources. The bill would take effect September 1, 2019.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
