IN RE: HB3552 by Sheffield (Relating to certain notice requirements regarding fluoridation of a water supply system.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Health and Safety Code to require certain notifications from a public water supply system prior to permanently terminating or reducing fluoridation of the water delivered by the system.
