IN RE: HB4031 by Murr (Relating to fees charged to a school district by a water supply or sewer service corporation.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Water Code to prohibit a sewer service corporation from charging a school district an impact fee or a fee to acquire water rights without entering into a contract with the district.

According to the Comptroller of Public Accounts, the bill would have no fiscal impact on the state.
