IN RE: HB4179 by Miller (Relating to the cemeteries in certain counties.), **As Engrossed**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Health and Safety Code to authorize certain counties to own and operate a cemetery and would modify an existing authorization that a commissioners court may maintain certain cemeteries 50 years old or greater.
