**Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Alcoholic Beverage Code as it relates the labeling of wine. The Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission and the Texas Department of Agriculture anticipate that the provisions of the bill would not result in a significant fiscal impact. The bill would take effect September 1, 2019.
