IN RE: HB4286 by Davis, Yvonne (Relating to the regulation of child-care providers by the Texas Workforce Commission.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Government Code relating to the regulation of child-care providers by the Texas Workforce Commission. Based on the analysis of the Texas Workforce Commission, it is assumed that the duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.
