IN RE: HB4296 by Schaefer (Relating to the regulation of plumbing, including the requirements to obtain a tradesman plumber-limited license.), Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Occupations Code relating to the regulation of plumbing, including the requirements to obtain a tradesman plumber-limited license. The bill would waive the apprenticeship registration and tradesman-plumber limited license fees for certain individuals but the revenue loss is not expected to be significant. Based on information provided by the Texas State Board of Plumbing Examiners, this analysis assumes that the duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.

The bill would take effect on September 1, 2019.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
