IN RE: HB4313 by Dominguez (Relating to the creation of an adaptive sports program by the University Interscholastic League to provide students with disabilities access to team sports.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill relates to the creation of an adaptive sports program by the University Interscholastic League (UIL) to provide students with disabilities access to team sports. Based on information provided by The University of Texas at Austin, any costs associated with implementing provisions of the bill could be absorbed within existing resources.

Local Government Impact

To the extent that the bill and associated agency rules require school districts to offer new or expanded UIL programs to students with disabilities, school districts and charter schools could see increased costs.
