IN RE: HB4350 by Bohac (Relating to public safety answering points operated by emergency communications districts.), **As Engrossed**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Health and Safety Code to add emergency service districts to a list of entities with the authority to provide fire-fighting, law enforcement, ambulance, medical, or other emergency services. The bill would also clarify that an existing authorization to transmit emergency response requests requires certain approvals from participating jurisdictions.

Local Government Impact
