**IN RE: HB4350** by Bohac (Relating to public safety answering points operated by emergency communications districts.), **As Engrossed** 

#### No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Health and Safety Code to add emergency service districts to a list of entities with the authority to provide fire-fighting, law enforcement, ambulance, medical, or other emergency services. The bill would also clarify that an existing authorization to transmit emergency response requests requires certain approvals from participating jurisdictions.

#### **Local Government Impact**
