**IN RE: HB4764** by Wray (Relating to the authority of the Midlothian Municipal Management District No. 3 to impose an ad valorem tax.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Special District Local Laws Code to allow ad valorem taxes in certain municipal management districts to exceed statutory thresholds in order to pay existing bonds or other obligations.

**Local Government Impact**
