**IN RE: HJR151** by Huberty (Proposing a constitutional amendment allowing increased distributions to the available school fund.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated,** other than the cost of publication.

The cost to the state for publication of the resolution is \$177,289.

The proposed amendment to the Texas Constitution would allow for, but not require, distributions up to \$600,000,000 to the Available School Fund from revenue derived during each fiscal year from land or properties of the Permanent School Fund.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
