IN RE: **SB86** by Hall (Relating to the regulation of raising or keeping chickens on single-family residential lots by a municipality.), **Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted**

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to prohibit a municipality from prohibiting an individual from raising or keeping six or few chickens on a single-family residential lot.
