**IN RE:** **SB86** by Hall (Relating to the regulation of raising or keeping chickens by a municipality or a property owners ' association.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Agriculture Code to prohibit a political subdivision or certain property owners' associations from prohibiting an individual from raising or keeping six or few chickens on a single-family residential lot.
