IN RE: SB124 by West (Relating to the authority of a county to require electronic bids or proposals for competitive bidding.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to authorize the Commissioners Court of a county to require submission of certain bids or proposals through electronic submission and remove an exiting requirement that hard copy bids be accepted.

Local Government Impact
