IN RE: SB185 by Miles (Relating to the response to certain oil or gas well accidents by state agencies and responsible parties.), Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Natural Resources Code related to the response to certain oil and gas well accidents by the Railroad Commission and operators of oil and gas wells. The bill would require additional reporting by oil and gas operators to the Railroad Commission and provide restrictions on certain oil and gas well operation permits.

The Railroad Commission estimates there would be a cost associated with implementing the provisions of the bill, however Legislative Budget Board analysis indicates any additional work resulting from enactment of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing state and federal resources.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
