**IN RE:** **SB235** by Nelson (Relating to the authority of certain municipalities to propose a fire control, prevention, and emergency medical services district.), **As Passed 2nd House**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to authorize certain municipalities to propose a fire control, prevention, and emergency medical services district.

**Local Government Impact**

According to the City of Corinth, the bill would allow a ballot proposition to redistribute City sales tax to a Fire District. The estimated range of redistributed dollars would be \$410,000 to \$820,000 annually.
