IN RE: SB311 by Perry (Relating to the frequency and location of certain meetings required by a prescriptive authority agreement.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Occupations Code relating to the frequency and location of certain meetings required by a prescriptive authority agreement.

The Texas Medical Board, Texas Board of Nursing, and Board of Pharmacy indicate they could absorb the costs associated with the bill within current resources.
