**IN RE: SB424** by West (Relating to determining appropriate disciplinary action to be taken against a public school student who is in foster care or who is homeless.), **As Introduced** 

### No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require school district or charter school officials to consider a student's homeless or foster care status as a factor in determining a disciplinary decision.

It is assumed that the provisions of the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.
