**IN RE: SB507** by Miles (Relating to authorizing a wellness and success center fee at the University of Houston-Downtown.), **As Introduced** 

#### No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

Under the provisions of the bill, the University of Houston System may levy a Wellness and Success Center fee for students enrolled at the University of Houston - Downtown not to exceed \$150 per student for each regular semester, \$75 per student for each summer session of eight weeks or longer, or \$50 per student for each summer session less than 8 weeks long.

The University estimates that if the fee was collected at the maximum rate provided for under the bill, revenue generated would be approximately \$4.2 million per year.

## **Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
