IN RE: SB772 by Hughes (Relating to evidence in certain civil actions of a person's failure to forbid handguns on certain property.), As Engrossed

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Civil Practice and Remedies Code concerning the admissibility of evidence showing that a person did not display a posting that forbids handguns on the property of a business. Based on the analysis of the Office of Court Administration, duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.
