**IN RE:** **SB790** by Buckingham (Relating to certain audit and reporting requirements of regional planning commissions.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to remove the Comptroller as a recipient of certain audit and reporting requirements of regional planning commissions.

According to the Comptroller of Public Accounts, there would be no administrative costs to the agency.
