IN RE: **SB893** by Menéndez (Relating to the requirement that the comptroller of public accounts receive copies of orders adopted in connection with the administration of elections.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

It is assumed that the provisions of the bill relating to the removal of requirements that the Comptroller of Public Accounts receive copies of certain orders adopted in connection with the administration of elections would not result in a significant fiscal impact.
