IN RE: **SB958** by Johnson (Relating to a right of first refusal applicable to the sale of housing developments that have received certain financial assistance administered by the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs.), **As Introduced**

The bill would amend the Government Code to add certain public housing authorities and public facility corporations to an existing authorization granting a right of first refusal applicable to the sale of certain housing developments.
