IN RE: SB1210 by Hancock (Relating to the removal of certain alcoholic beverages that become unfit for consumption after a natural disaster.), Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Alcoholic Beverage Code as it relates to the removal of certain alcoholic beverages after a natural disaster. The Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commissions anticipates that the provisions of the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2019.
