IN RE: **SB1575** by Alvarado (Relating to governmental immunity for and adjudication of claims arising from a local governmental entity's disaster recovery contract.), **As Passed 2nd House**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Civil Practice and Remedies Code and the Local Government Code to provide governmental immunity to a certain local governments for a cause of action arising from a disaster recovery contract following the declaration of a disaster.
