**IN RE:** **SB1575** by Alvarado (relating to governmental immunity for and adjudication of claims arising from a local governmental entity's disaster recovery contract.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Civil Practice and Remedies Code to provide governmental immunity to a certain local governments for a cause of action arising from a disaster recovery contract following the declaration of a disaster.
