- **IN RE: SB1694** by Johnson (Relating to authorizing a regulatory authority to establish reduced water and sewer utility rates funded by donations for the benefit of certain low-income customers.), **As Introduced**

#### No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require the Public Utility Commission (PUC) to establish rules that permit water and wastewater utilities to expand a program that provides reduced rates to certain customers. The PUC anticipates the agency would do so within existing resources.

### Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
