IN RE: **SB1788** by Zaffirini (Relating to the payment of costs associated with certain education programs of The University of Texas Health Science Center.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Chapter 660 of the Government Code to allow funds appropriated for the education of university students at the Laredo Regional Campus of The University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio to be used to pay for educational program costs, including ground or air transportation, lodging, meals, training costs, and related expenses.

The bill would result in no significant fiscal implication to the state, based on information provided by the Higher Education Coordinating Board and The University of Texas System.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
