**IN RE:** **SB2072** by Taylor (Relating to the authority of a development corporation created by the Gulf Coast Authority to finance certain projects.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Acts of the 61st Legislature, 1969, to authorize certain development corporations to finance qualified improvements in the same manner as a municipality or county may and without approval of another entity other than the authority and to finance certain projects related to the creation or retention of primary jobs.

**Local Government Impact**

The fiscal implications of the bill on development corporations subject to its provisions cannot be determined at this time.
