**IN RE: SJR27** by Huffman (Proposing a constitutional amendment prohibiting the use of state funds to pay for the obligations of a local public retirement system.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated**, other than the cost of publication.

The cost to the state for publication of the resolution is \$177,289.

The joint resolution would propose a constitutional amendment prohibiting the state from appropriating money to a local public retirement system.

**Local Government Impact**

According to the Texas Municipal League, no fiscal impact is anticipated.

According to the Texas Municipal Retirement System (TMRS), the bill would not have a fiscal impact because TMRS is a statewide retirement system, not a local system, and does not receive state appropriated funds.
